Recreation access on the east side of the park is open at Two Medicine, Cut Bank and St. Mary for foot traffic, skis and snowshoes. Regular winter vehicle closures remain in place. The west entrance gate is open. Depending on weather conditions the road will be open to Lake McDonald Lodge. Recreation access is permitted beyond the vehicle closure on the west side of the Going-to-the-Sun Road. Skiing and snowshoeing along the road are popular winter and spring activities. Backcountry permit advance reservations is now open. Road construction and project work will impact travel on park roads in 2021.

As tribal governments continue to assess public health risks, travel restrictions may change at any time depending on current conditions. In general, visitors may still drive through reservations in order to access other areas but should save any on-reservation activity until after the pandemic.
